Ticket Talk . . . Mae Rosenkranz

You should have received your 2017 Projection Sheet in the mail by now. So, look it over, fill it out and **return it at the February 13th meeting**. If you've not received yours yet, please contact me ASAP! The Dodgers are enforcing some new rules this year regarding our payment for tickets. Payment for all tickets ordered must accompany the ticket order itself. What this means is that each time when I place my ticket order with the Dodgers, I must also pay for them at the same time. This is because ALL tickets will be digitally transmitted to me this year.

The Dodgers will no longer print tickets for us unless we wish to pay a \$40 fee for each game. Therefore, I will be sending your tickets to you digitally as well. If you want me to print out your tickets, there will be a fee of \$1 per ticket. The Dodgers will require that all tickets must be ordered and paid for a minimum of 30 days prior to game date. This means I must have your payment in my hands much sooner than just 30 days before the game date. My suggestion to everyone is to pay for all your tickets at the same time, if possible, or to pay for tickets ordered at least 2 homestands ahead of time. Remember, in addition to paying with cash or check, you may also use a credit card to pay for tickets, subject to a small CC service charge. As of this writing, I still **do not have the Opening Day ticket price**. Be sure to watch your email for any club email alerts regarding price, payment and deadline for these tickets. PARKING this year will be \$10 if paid in advance online or \$20 at the gate. For those with Mini Plans, there will be no more \$1 discount on parking if bought for those games all at once before the season starts. Therefore, everyone will be responsible for buying their own parking online with the Dodgers prior to game time or at the parking gates. **DON'T FORGET YOUR FINAL MINI PLAN PAYMENT IS DUE by FEBRUARY 23rd.**

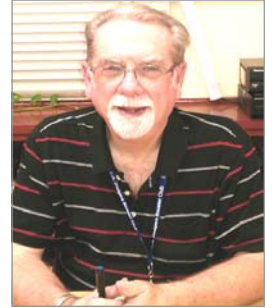
2017 Membership Drive . . . Danee Gallegos

Member Spotlight - Ben Lee . . .

Ben Lee has been an active member of our club for 10 years now. As you know, Ben, along with the Armenta sisters, have designed, created and donated the centerpieces for our annual Christmas party for many years now. They are always beautiful and elegant, adding just that right touch to enhance the holiday spirit for not only our gatherings, but any quality event.

Ben is a floral designer by trade. At last year's party, a comment was made about him winning a statewide floral competition recently. He gave us a modest and short account of it. As editor, I'm always intrigued to learn more about what our members do when they are not at Dodger games or involved in our club activities and to potentially share that with our members. I pressed him later for more information and here's some of the good stuff I learned:

On this past November 6th, Ben participated in the California State Floral Association Top Ten Design Competition. This is a statewide competition to determine the best floral designer in California using California grown products. Designers must create two different designs on the day of the competition. The first design is a "designer's choice" piece where the designers are given the theme prior to the competition. This design is used to show the designer's creativity. This year's theme was "Walk the Line".

The second design that day was the appropriately named "Surprise Package" and counted for 60% of the overall score. For this one, all the competitors were given the same products and then told the theme of the design in order to determine who could come up with the best interpretation of that theme. This year's theme was to create a reception table arrangement for a new client who is a high-rise architectural firm. Ben won the title of First Place Winner and the People's Choice Award that day with his two designs.

As the state winner, he is now eligible to compete on the national level later this September, to be held in Florida.

Congrats and way to go Ben!
